What are the AEMA badges?

THe badges recognise the commitment of adult education providers (AEP) and experts to making learning accessible. There are 3 levels of badges, each one corresponding to a different level of commitment.

- AEP Level 1: it is the initial commitment. Anybody who wants to support the AEMA values of adult learning accessibility can get this badge after reviewing their organisation using the Accessibility Maturity Matrix.
- AEP Level 2: this badge recognises that an organisation has demonstrated some progress in one domain making learning more accessible to learners with disabilities.
- AEP Level 3: this badge recognises that an organisation has demonstrated an extended and continuous commitment to making learning more accessible to learners with disabilities.
- -Accessbility experts: Individual badges recognise an accessibility expert in one or more domains of accessibility.

How are badges delivered?

How can you claim a badge as an adult education provider?:

Level 1 badge: After performing a review on the Maturity Matrix you will receive the badge.

For badges level 2 and 3 the organizations will have to support evidence. The applicant must provide supporting evidence. When the claim passes successfully the review the badge will be delivered by AEMA.

How can an expert claim a badge?

Experts will have to support evidence that will be reviewed by their clients. The applicant must provide supporting evidence .When the claim passes successfully the review the badge will be delivered by AEMA.
